Hurricane Season 2007

The Atlantic Hurricane Season runs June 1st until November 30th. The most active time is roughly August 15th until September 30th. Preparation is the key!! For every year, there is a pre-approved list of names for tropical storms & hurricanes. These lists have been generated by the National Hurricane Center since 1953. At first, the lists consisted of only female names; however, since 1979, the lists alternate between male and female. Hurricanes are named alphabetically from the list in chronological order. Thus the first tropical storm or hurricane of the year has a name that begins with "A". Tropical Storm Andrea showed up in the Atlantic May 9th!! No hurricanes are named beginning with the letter O or U. There are six lists that continue to rotate. The lists only change where there is a hurricane that is so devastating the name is retired and another name replaces it.

Access Card & Transponder Renewal

In an effort to better manage accessibility to the Community and Clubhouse, all residents will be required to renew their access cards and transponders.

Starting July 1st, each Village will be assigned a period of time to complete this process. Proof of residency will be required to renew access cards. The number of transponders issued per household will be based on two criteria; vehicular space at the home and number of vehicles owned. Residents will be asked to present vehicle registration for each transponder issued. More detailed information will be provided on our website, www.olympiapb.org, through direct mail and at the Clubhouse later this month.
