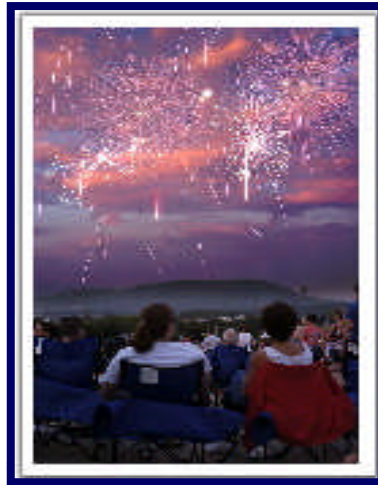

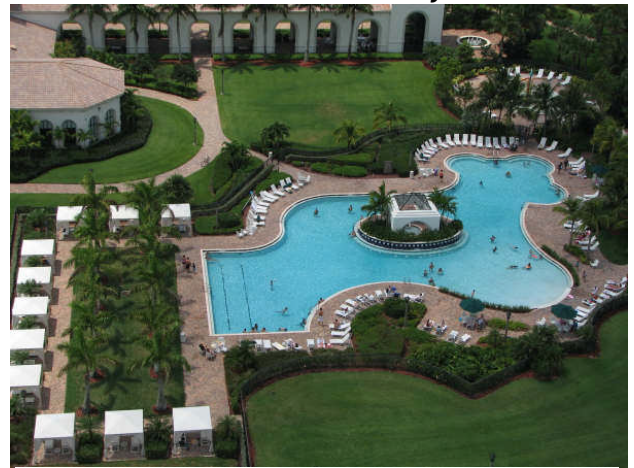

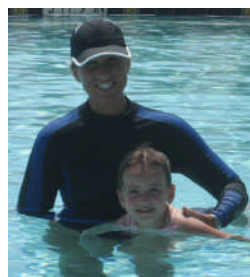

Community Improvement Projects

- Curb refurbishment has begun around Fatio Blvd. and throughout various Villages. Please exhibit caution when driving near coned areas.
- A second lift of asphalt will be laid around the balance of Fatio Blvd. Please expect minimal delays when traveling Fatio Blvd.
- A brightly identified bike lane will be added to Fatio Blvd.
- Olympia monuments have been pressure cleaned and sealed. Pavers at the Forest Hill Bridge and Hutton Blvd. entrance will be pressure cleaned and sealed after the asphalt has been laid.
- 4,350 Red and Gold Coleus plants were planted to add color to our perimeter areas.
- Palm Trees and Hardwoods will be trimmed beginning later this summer. Please exercise caution around working vehicles.
- All Common areas received mulch to brighten up the landscape beds.
- Kidde Works Interactive Fountain at the Pool was repainted and waxed.

Water Restrictions Still in Effect

- Odd street addresses may irrigate lawns and landscapes on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 12am to 10am and/or 4pm to 11:59pm.
- Even street addresses may irrigate lawns and landscapes on Thursdays and Sundays from 12am to 10am and/or 4pm to 11:59pm.
- Please check with your village association for your designated watering times.
- Hand-watering with one hose fitted with an automatic shut-off nozzle is allowed for 10 minutes per day for landscape stress relief and to prevent plant die-off.
- No restrictions apply to other outside water uses, such as for car and boat washing, pressure cleaning of paved surfaces, decorative fountains and water-based recreation (e.g. swimming pools, water slides)
