



Summer Fun Facts... We've Been Busy!

- Over 120 yards of sanitized play sand was added to the Picnic and Playground.
- Over 36 yards of sanitized sand was added to the outdoor volleyball court. An Indoor Volleyball Court was purchased-watch for a Volleyball League in Sept.
- Over 320 Coconut & Royal Palms, and Washingtonian Trees on the Clubhouse grounds and Common Areas were trimmed.
- 224,297,000 square feet of Clubhouse & Guardhouse exterior surfaces were pressure cleaned & milguarded.
- 236,350 gallons of water from the Main Pool flows through 27 cleansing filters 4 times a day.
- On a daily basis, the Clubhouse staff collects up to 23 bags of trash from the grounds.
