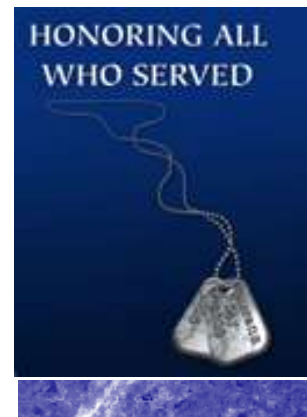

TRIBUTE TO HEROES DEDICATION TO PEACE

Olympia residents join the Nation in honoring veterans that have served and those serving now in peace keeping missions all over the world. At 11:00 am on the eleventh day of the eleventh month of 1918, the armistice ending the "War to end all Wars" was signed and World War I was over. In November of 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day honoring World War I veterans. On June 1, 1954, November 11th became a day to honor American veterans of all wars. Later that same year, on October 8th, President Eisenhower issued the first "Veterans' Day Proclamation". Olympia residents are encouraged to fly the American flag. The Village of Wellington will hold its Veterans' Day Celebration on Sunday, November 11th beginning with a parade at 8:45am followed by an observance at Veterans' Memorial at 9:00am. Village of Wellington has implemented an award to recognize and show appreciation for individual property owners for an outstanding job of landscaping designs and maintenance. Any resident within the Village of Wellington limits may nominate themselves or be nominated. Residential criteria for evaluation include:

- How does your property look, does it have curb appeal? Is it free of trash and debris?
- What percentages of native plantings (shrubs and trees) have been incorporated?
- Is it environmentally friendly? Have Xeriscape practices been used?
- Is there a particular theme or style carried throughout the entire landscaped area of property?
