Access Card & Transponder Re-Registration Begins September 1st

In an effort to better manage accessibility to the Community and Clubhouse and to ensure we have correct and current data, all residents will be required to update their access cards, transponders and permanent guests lists. Starting September 1st, residents in each Village will be assigned a period of time to complete this process. Please see schedule below:

The number of transponders issued per household will be based on two criteria; vehicular space at the home and number of vehicles owned. Examples are as follows:

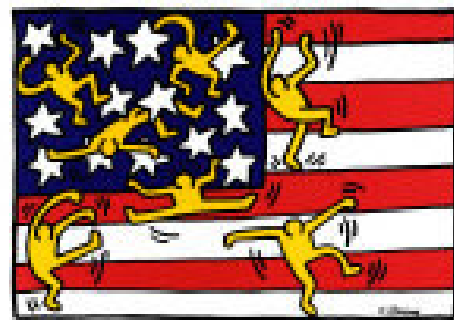
Example 1- A home with a two car garage and four vehicles registered to the home will be able to have four transponders.
Example 2- A home with a three car garage and two vehicles registered to the home will be able to have two transponders.

All residents will receive a "Gate and Clubhouse Access Data Form" in the mail. This form is also available on our website www.olympiapb.org. Please complete the form and bring it with you to the clubhouse on your scheduled day. Please bring the following with you to verify your data:

- All transponders and club cards in your possession.
- Copy of water or electric bill to verify residency.
- Copy of Village Lease Approval letter for tenants.
- Valid drivers license with an Olympia address for everyone with a clubhouse ID.
- Valid vehicle registration with an Olympia address for all vehicles that have a transponder.

Please note all transponders and Clubhouse IDs not listed and verified will be disabled on October 1st, 2009.
